Registering in your Catholic parish is important because it signifies your active participation in our community, allows you to access sacraments and parish services, contribute to the life of the church, and build meaningful connections with fellow parishioners within your local area; essentially, it's a way to formally become part of your local Catholic community and actively live out your faith. In a practical way, registering also helps our parish office to provide statistics which are an important way we plan ahead. It is especially important if you worship with us but live outside of the parish boundaries - if you make official requests, unfortunately we are left asking you to contact the geographic parish where you reside.
