# Welcome Back Breakfasts & After Mass Socials

On <u>Sunday September 15th</u> we look forward to welcoming everyone back with our Welcome Back breakfasts at 9:30am and 11:15am in the Parish Hall, inviting all parishioners to attend. We will be charging a nominal fee of \$5.00, which will go towards the Parish Building Fund.

At the breakfasts as well as the <u>Coffee/Cider socials</u> (<u>after all other Masses this weekend</u>) we will have many of our parish ministries on display on the peripheries of the Parish Hall.

## Parish Sound System

Our sound system has served us well for 20 years, but recent malfunctions and outdated components mean repairs are no longer viable. We need to replace the system at a cost of around \$50,000. Fortunately, our speakers are still in good condition. Beginning mid-September, we will explore fund raising for the system upgrades as well as installing a permanent projector for music, devotions, and more.

## **Connecting with Your Priests**

Our priests, Father Chris and Father Daniel work hard to serve all the parishioners of St. Bernadette's to the best of their abilities, but we recognize that there are several people dropping by the office expecting to find a priest available in his office. Unfortunately, much of their work is away from their desks.
