Update on Building/ Property Work

At present, we have AWL Construction working on the Universal Washroom in the Parish Hall, which we hope to have completed and in use by the Fall. This is located at the front of the Parish Hall where the Janitor's closet was. When that is completed, a smaller Janitor's Closet will be located at the back of the hall. Work is also being done on the basement washrooms as well.

A very generous parishioner who has provided our Parish Kitchen with a beautiful facelift, helping us get better use from our kitchen in the years ahead – we are so grateful for that.

Phase One of our property redevelopment is completed now, and it seems the Lord has provided us with the nourishment, as the front lawn and trees seem to be doing very well. We are continuing to schedule staff to water these areas where possible. The future phases will be smaller, as we continue in the years ahead to bring natural beauty to the grounds at St. Bernadette's

The Finance Council will also be considering quotes that we have received for the Parish Hall roof, which we are looking to start in the Fall, which should not affect our meeting space and Fall Ministry programming.

Upcoming Special Request

The sound system in our church is coming to the end of its life. We are faced with a major parish expense in the months ahead, as we now must consider replacing major components of the church sound system, an expense that will cost us around \$50,000. We are pricing this out and more information in our next bulletin.
