Lent

Ash Wednesday marked the beginning of Lent, offering a special opportunity to renew our full commitment to God. One of the wonderful Lenten traditions we honour is fasting (on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday) and abstaining from meat on Fridays. These practices aren't meant to be restrictive, but to help us open our hearts, minds, and souls to the sacrifices made for us, especially by our Lord Jesus Christ. Additionally, making time for the Sacrament of Penance (confession) more regularly during Lent is a great way to deepen our spiritual journey. To support this, parishes, including St. Bernadette's, offer more opportunities for confession during this season.

We also simplify our liturgies during Lent to reflect the profound yet simple Gift of Life that Jesus gave us, culminating on Good Friday. This includes removing flowers, using fewer altar candles and adornments at Mass, and simplifying hymns and prayers. We will also take a break from communal devotions (Prayer to St. Bernadette on Saturday, Our Lady of Perpetual Help on Wednesdays - to focus on the beauty of Lent - although our personal devotions can and should help us draw closer to our Lord's sacrifices and Gift of Himself. We also draw closer as a community offering the Stations of the Cross. On Fridays during Adoration, we will pray the Litany of Penance instead of the Litany to the Sacred Heart.
