My dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend marks the end of the Christmas season, as we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. One of the most dramatic accounts of Jesus' own baptism comes from those who are there, a sense that the skies opened up and the Father proclaimed, "this is My Son, the Beloved, in Whom I AM well pleased." Friends, our own baptism

should never be seen as less impactful or dramatic or profound as Jesus'. For us to see it as "less than" isn't just a lessening of ourselves and our own capacity for greatness, but also a diminishing of Jesus' greatness – as He shared His baptism with all of us. Friends, we were made for greatness and our own baptism which is an extension of the Baptism of the Lord, was and is our starting point. I encourage us all to take a few moments to meditate on our own baptism and let us begin again as Christians.


